Reading

Reading groups have been determined. You should have found a note attached to your child's assignment book Monday. It is possible that some children change groups during the year according to their progress. Please review the Handbook for Reading (HB) pages daily with your child according to their group. Daily homework is in your child's assignment book or online.

Math

I will be introducing the concept of greater than. The students will learn how to solve a story problem. We will review counting to 100 and the addition families one through five, plus the "twins". (Ex. 1 + 2 = 3; 2 + 1 = 3)

Tip: Flashcards are a great practice at home.

Handwriting

We review proper posture and proper pencil grip daily. We are practicing writing our numbers 1-10 as well as letters *l*, *s*, *c*, *b*, and *t*. Please practice handwriting at home. Please keep at home the letter formation card which were sent home last week. This is a helpful guide to encourage your child to form their letters correctly. It is helpful if you practice nightly the letters stated above.

Things to remember

1. Sign and return your child's planner every day.
2. Blue folder goes home daily. Check if there is work to correct/return or to keep at home. Please return blue folder daily.
3. Review verse daily with your child.
