### Phonics Tests - Thursdays

The students have been studying the one and two vowel rules and Charts 6, 7, and 8. To help prepare your child for this test review all the Letters & Sound and Language papers that have been sent home this week and the charts on page 60 and 75 in the Handbook for Reading. Spelling List 4 will go home on Thursday.



BOOK-IT began Oct. 1 - The October calendar was in the Wednesday packet last week. Your child should read 20 minutes per day (at least 5 times per week) of supplemental reading - Please have your child color in the Book-It calendar each day they read. Parents, please initial on the calendar beside each day they read.

The students read twice aloud to themselves and one time out loud to the parent.

Read daily with your children even if they do not have reading homework.



## Handwriting

Please practice cursive writing and proper pencil "two finger pinch/ third finger rest" grip at home. On Mondays students should practice cursive letters to help prepare them for their test on Tuesdays. Please continue working on the letters b, p, f, and capital I. We have also worked on our first and last names in cursive!
