Phonics: This week we are learning and reviewing the special sounds "ck" in duck, "o" in go, "st" in stop, "pl" in plane, "sh" in ship, "th" in thick, "ay" in pray, "fr" in frog, "e" in me, "tr" in train, and "y" in fly. Please practice and continue marking vowels.

Reading: Reading groups will continue this week. Please remember to do and turn in Book-its. Book-its are due 2/28 for February.

Handwriting: This week we are learning capital letters T and S. We are continuing to learn first names in cursive. Please practice at home.

Math: Addition families 1-8, counting to 100, **by 10's, by 5's and counting nickels, dimes and pennies**, number words (one-ten).

Social Studies: We are learning about Africa.
