Bible: Hebrews 13:8 “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”

Phonics:

Introduced: “h” as in horse, “s” as in sun, “c” as in cat. We also worked on the blend ladders for these consonants and the c/k blend ladders. Etc. he+n = hen, sa+t = sat, cu+p = cup. Sight word: “the”

Handwriting: The cursive letters: *h, s, c.*

*Remember to keep your letters on the appropriate line. Extra practice sheets sent home do not have to be completed that night. It is just to benefit your child and to be completed when you have time. Sometimes you have to hold your child’s hand as they complete the first few letters to help them with formation.

Math: Introduced: The number SIX (6). The numbers fourteen and fifteen. Ordinal numbers: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th) vs. Cardinal numbers (1,2,3,4)
