Bible: Matt. 20:16 “So the last will be first, and the first will be last.”

Phonics:

Introduced: “d” as in dog, “g” as in goat. We also worked on the blend ladders for these consonants ladders. Etc. de+n = den, ge+t = get, cu+p = cup. Sight word: “a”, “at”, “in”, “on”, “it”, “said”

Handwriting: The cursive letters: *d, g*.

*Remember to keep your letters on the appropriate line. Extra practice sheets sent home do not have to be completed that night. It is just to benefit your child and to be completed when you have time. Sometimes you have to hold your child’s hand as they complete the first few letters to help them with formation.

Math: Introduced: The number SEVEN (7). The numbers sixteen and seventeen. **Review:** Ordinal numbers: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th) vs. Cardinal numbers (1,2,3,4) and the value of a penny.
