Bible Verse:

Phonics:

Introduced. This week's new "Special Sounds" is: "ou" in out.

Reviewed: Reviewed the Special Sounds: "squ" in squeak, "thr" in three, "ar" in star, "or" in morning, "ch" in church, "spl" as in splash, "spr" in sprain and "scr" scream, "sw" in swim, "sp" in spade, "tw" in twin, "cr' in crab, "sn" in snack, "sl" in sleep, "spl" in splash, "ql" in glue, "fl" in flake,"br" in bride, "dr" in drum, "pr" in pray, "gr" in grin, "sm" in smoke, "sc" in scat, "sk" in skate, "bl" in block, "cl" in clock, "v" in fly, "av" in pray, "st" in stop, "pl" in plane, "fr" in frog, "tr" in train, "ck" in duck, "e" in me, "o" in go. (When marking words, we circle all the "Special Sounds" and then "mark" the vowels!)

Handwriting:

Introduce: The capital "G". Review: The capital "L" "M" and "D" in cursive.

Science:

God's World Book. Continuing our study on the Butterfly Stages. Our caterpillars are now in the chrysalis stage. We are so excited to see them emerge as beautiful butterflies in a couple of weeks!

Math:

Please help your child memorize the One through Nine Addition Families. This is the foundation in Math for first and second grade. 3-5 min. review a night makes a big difference.

Introduced: Subtracting One (1-1=0, 2-1=1, 3-1=2)


