Bible:

Next Week: Hebrews 13:8 "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever."

Phonics: Phonics:

Introduced: "t" as in table and "l" as in lamp.

Review: "a" as in apple, "e" as in elephant, "i" as in indian "o" as in ostrich, and "u" as in umbrella. **Note:** Your child should be able to identify all 26 letters in the alphabet and be able to identify the five short vowel sounds in most three letter words.

Handwriting: Cursive writing continues this week with writing the letters 'a', 'e', 'o', 'u' and 'i'. **Parents please work with your child on how to write their name in print. Do not mix capital and lowercase letters. Remind your child the proper way to hold a pencil with only the pointer finger on top—"Pinch and pull".**

Math: Reviewed: "Top, Middle, Bottom", numbers 1-9, "Above and Below" and writing the number one & two.

Introduced: Right/Left, patterns, shapes, "Same/Different", "Before and After" and writing the number three.
