Bible:

Phonics: Phonics:

Introduced: "g" as in goat and "c" as in cat. We also worked on the blend ladders for these consonants and the c/k blend ladders. Etc. he+n = hen, sa+t = sat, cu+p = cup. Sight words: "the" and "a"

***Note: Your child should be able to identify all 26 letters in the alphabet and be able to identify the five short vowel sounds in most three letter words

Handwriting: The cursive "g", "d", "c", "s", "m", "h", "b", "n", "u", "e", "a", "o", "t", "l", "te", nu, and "lu". Remind your child the proper way to hold a pencil with only the pointer finger on top—"Pinch and pull". If you have any questions feel free to give me a call

<u>Math:</u> The number SEVEN (7). The numbers seventeen and eighteen. **Review:** Ordinal numbers: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th) vs. Cardinal numbers (1,2,3,4) and the value of a penny

Reviewed: Right/Left, Greater than, less than, patterns, shapes, "Same/Different", "Before and After" and writing the number 6.
