Phonics: This week we are learning and reviewing the special sounds: “ck” in duck, “o” in go, “st” in stop, “pl” in plane, “sh” in ship, “th” in thick, “ay” in pray, “fr” in frog, “e” in me, “tr” in train, and “y” in fly, “th” in this and “th” in thick, “br” in bride and “dr” in drum, “bl” in block, “cl” in clock, “fl” in flag, “gl” in glue, “br” in bride, “dr” in drum, “pr” in pray and “gr” in grin. Please practice and continue marking vowels. A list and new calendar went home this week.
