Phonics: This week we are reviewing the special sounds “ck” in duck, “o” in go, “st” in stop, “pl” in plane, “sh” in ship, “th” in thick, “ay” in pray, “fr” in frog, “e” in me, “tr” in train, “y” in fly, “th” in this, “th” in thick, “br” in bride and “dr” in drum. New this week “sp” in spade, “cr” in crab and “tw” in twin. We are adding “sn” in snack, “sl” in sleep and “sw” in swim. Please practice and continue marking vowels. We will have a Phonics test every week.

Reading: Reading groups will continue this week. We will have a Reading test every other week starting next week.

Handwriting: We are learning last names in cursive and capital letters in cursive. Please practice at home.

Math: Addition families 1-10, counting to 100, by 10’s, by 5’s and counting nickels, dimes, pennies, and quarters. Practice number words (one-ten), time to the hour and half hour.

Science: We start our science books this week. We are also starting to learn about butterfly life cycles this week.
