Handwriting

We review proper posture and proper pencil grip daily. We are practicing writing our numbers 1-10 as well as letters *I*, *s*, *c*, *b*, and *t*. Please practice handwriting at home. Please keep at home the letter formation card which were sent home last week. This is a helpful guide to encourage your child to form their letters correctly. It is helpful to practice nightly.
