Bible: Acts 17:26 “From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth.”

Phonics:

Introduced: “Xx” says “ks” as in fox and box, “Zz” says “Z” as in zebra. **Sight words:** “the”, “a”, “an”, “it”, “in”, “on”, “and”, “at”, “said”

Handwriting: We are learning to connect letters in cursive to make words. Practice first and last name in print. This is a skill on the report card.

Math:

Introduced The 70’s (70-79) and 80’s family (80-89), counting by 10’s, 1-2 addition families (1+0, 2+0, 1+1)

Reviewed: The 60’s family (60-69), 50’s family (50-59) 40’s family (40-49) 30’s family (30-39) family 20’s (20-29) Numbers zero-59. The “Fathers of the Twenty and Thirty Families.” We also worked on the One family (0-9) and the Teen Family (10-19). We practiced writing numbers eight and nine, knowing the penny, our left and right, Telling Time to the Hour and counting to 79.

Social Studies: We are learning about other countries. This week we will learn about: Mexico
