A Peek at our Week in Kindergarten

Bible: Genesis 6:22 “Noah did everything just as God commanded him.”

Phonics:

Introduced: This week introduced the “Special Sounds”: “bl” in block, “cl” in clock, “gl” in glue, “pr” in pray, “gr” in grin.

Reviewed: Reviewed the Special Sounds “ck” in duck, “o” in go, “e” in me, “y” in fly, “ay” in pray, “sh” in ship, “th” in thick, “th” in this, “tr” in train, “fr” in frog, “fl” in flake. (When marking words, we circle all the “Special Sounds” and then “mark” the vowels!)

Two Vowel Rule” “When two vowels go walking, the first one does the talking and says its long name (“---”)...the second one is silent (/).” One Vowel Rule: “u” (smile on top of the short vowel) bat, dig. Sight word: “the”, “a”, “an”, “it”, “do”, “to”, “of”, “off”.

Handwriting:

Introduced: The capital “C” in cursive.

Reviewed: We are working Capital Letters: “B”, “A”, “T”, “I”, “S”, and “J”.

Writing whole words and sentences. ☺

Social Studies:

We are continuing our “Children of the World” series. We are learning about **Japan and Australia!**

Introduced: Seven Addition Family (7+0, 1+6,2+5,3+4, 4+3,5+2, 6+1, 0+7), the number words: seven, eight, nine, ten and time to the half hour!

Reviewed: Fathers of the Teen-Ninety Families. The Nickel (five cents) The Dime (10 cents) The Penny (1 cent). Time to the Hour, counting to 100 and Counting by 10’s. Six Addition Family” (6+0, 5+1, 4+2, 3+3, 2+4, 1+5, 0+6). We have learned the number words: one, two, three, and four, five and six. Parts of the calendar and “after numbers”.
