<u>A Peek at our Week in Kindergarten</u>

Bible: This weeks Bible memory verse: Psalm 86:10 For you are great and do marvelous deeds; you alone are God. We will say our Bible verse in chapel every Thursday and we will have a test every Friday. Phonics: This week we will review our first short
vowel sounds - "i" as in Indian and "u" as in
umbrella. We will introduce "e" as in egg and "a" as
in apple. Please fill the brown bags with an item that
matches the vowel sound and send them back in the
following day.

<u>Handwriting:</u> Cursive writing begins this week with writing the letter "i" and "u". Practice holding a pencil properly with only the pointer finger on the top.

<u>Math:</u> We are currently reviewing number recognition and the proper formation of numbers one through ten. We are also studying "same and different", making our own "patterns" and "sorting".
