1. Academic Overview:

- a. Six Basic Steps to Reading review Vowels, Blend Ladders make a word Ta plus p is TAP.
- b. Updated Student's Progress/Grades via internet. Renweb (You can get your log in from the school office).
- c. Weekly Behavior Reports remember to sign and return (Secret Word)
- d. Handwriting Procedures Please practice cursive & first name in print.

Grading scale for Kindergarten is as follows:

100-93: "A" or O 92-84: "B" or S 83-76: "C" or S-75-69: "D" or N 68-0: "F" or U

e. First nine weeks of Kindergarten is review of pre-school – Students should be doing VERY WELL at this point. Most papers except for tests are done together with the teacher.

- f. We understand that Handwriting in cursive is new and may be a low score at first. Please take time to work with your child as we will so that they will improve. Honor Roll does not start until Third Quarter.
- g. There are very few graded papers for the first quarter of the year. By the end of the first nine weeks, students will have received five phonics grades, four math grades, three handwriting grades and eight Bible grades.
- h. **Green (outstanding) behavior criteria.** "Slow obedience, is No obedience." They have <u>many chances</u> to do the right thing © If your child is off green they will have no punch card in their folder. Ask them what color they are on (most likely yellow). If they are on red, blue or white you will have a detailed behavior report in your child's folder. It must be signed and returned the following day.

2. Housekeeping items:

- a. **Bathroom procedures** Does your child have a change of clothes here at school? Accidents can happen but they can use the restroom at any time. They just have to ask to go. We cannot dress your child. They must be able to button, zip, and change themselves.
- b. Lunch money should be turned in on Wednesday mornings.

 Please make sure the money and the form are together clearly labeled with your child's name on it. Please send exact change.

- c. Be working on addresses and phone numbers and first name in print. Tests start next week. These are First Quarter requirements to pass Kindergarten.
- d. Absences/Tardies 3 tardies = 1 absence.
- e. **Sleep** We are seeing more and more children falling asleep in class or walking into the classroom exhausted and complaining that they are too tired to stand or do work. Your child should be getting 10-12 hours of sleep per night. According to National Sleep Foundation study on children and sleep, "Sleep is especially important for children as it directly impacts mental and physical development." Watching T.V or playing on computers close to bedtime can lead to difficulty falling asleep and anxiety.
