Phonics Tests - Thursdays

1st Phonics Test - Sept. 8

We are continuing work on short vowel sound with blends. The phonics is integrated in our reading and writing. The students are showing progress in remembering what they have already learned!



READING

The students read twice aloud to themselves and one time out loud to the parent. Watch the assignment daily. There is reading homework every day except Wednesday. Homework assignments will be in their assignment books and on the calendar on my website portal.

Starting today

I will be introducing the concept of greater than. The students will learn how to solve a story problem. We will review counting to 100 and the addition families one through five, plus the "twins".
