<u>Phonics/Spelling Tests - Thursdays</u> <u>The ck/ke rule</u>: When you hear a k sound at the end of a word and the vowel is short, you write ck. When the vowel is long, you write k and a silent e. Review all the Letters & Sound and Language papers. <u>Spelling List 5 due Friday.</u>

- 4. Pencil held properly pinch and rest
